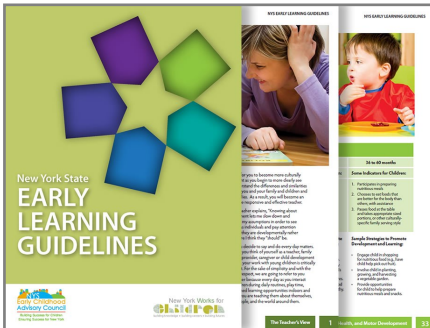


PLANNING FOR A NEW SCHOOL YEAR? PUBLICATIONS ARE NOW AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE

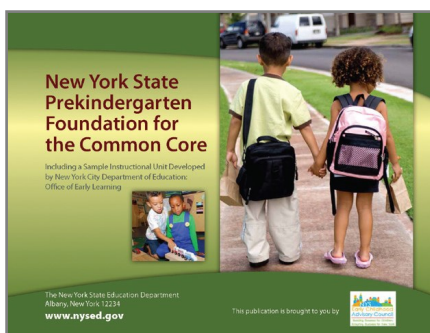
